TRACK

- Don't forget your tickets!** Skip the lines and purchase in advance to save time and money. You'll find all available ticket purchase links at <https://worldofoutlaws.com/schedule/>. NOTE: Unlike other sports, the preferred seats are higher up in the grandstands, where you can see the whole track and stay clear of flying dirt. Make sure to print your tickets or download them to your phone before arriving at the track.
- Read your Know Before You Go email.** You'll receive this email before Race Day if you've purchased your tickets from us in advance. Read it thoroughly for any special instructions or information — and for event details and directions.
- Download the World of Outlaws app.** You'll have event info, news, preliminary rosters, driver bios, and championship points standing right at your fingertips.
- Review the track FAQs for details regarding track rules.** Are coolers allowed? Is alcohol permitted? Can you protect your backside from hours of sitting with a comfy stadium seat? You'll find this information on the FAQ tab of the EVENT INFO page from <https://worldofoutlaws.com/schedule/>. There is also an FAQ link in your Know Before You Go email. Know the rules before you go.
- Check the weather.** You'll be outside for quite some time — often without cover. Be sure to dress and prepare accordingly. On hotter days, wear cool, loose-fitting clothing, take sunglasses, and don't forget sunscreen! Some warm days can get quite cool in the evening. Take a sweatshirt or jacket — or even a blanket, gloves, and a hat. Remember, if you forgot something, you can always check out our Souvenir Trailer for a solution.
- Wear comfortable shoes** — especially if you have a Pit Pass. Sure, they're short tracks, but a few walks around one makes for a lot of steps.
- Sitting near a turn?** You probably want to pack some safety goggles to protect your eyes from flying dirt.
- Race cars are LOUD. Take your earplugs** — or stop at the Souvenir Trailer early on to get some.
- Tune into DIRTVision.** Sign up for free to get access to the VIDEO VAULT and watch the last few races so you're up to speed.
- New to racing?** Check out our education hub.
- Take cash.** Many of our tracks now accept credit cards and/or have ATMs, but that is not always the case, and sometimes service is lost. You don't want to go hungry or miss out on a stellar event T-shirt, so hit that ATM before you get to the track to be safe.
- Plan on taking a lot of photos?** Pack an extra battery pack or charger for your phone in your pocket — or take a camera. Nothing is worse than your phone going dead just in time for the 4-wide.
- Be an Outlaw! Sign up for our Fan Rewards program** at <https://www.be-an-outlaw.com/> and add your Digital Outlaw Card to your phone wallet. When you get to the track, scan your card for a chance to win exclusive at-track experiences like a ride in the Pace Car or get your photo taken with the winner in Victory Lane!
- Arrive early so you can spend some time perusing the Midway.** Enjoy the fan experience and merchandise offerings, including driver and event t-shirts, hats, and hoodies.
- Hydrate. Hydrate. Hydrate.** With all the fun and excitement, don't forget that your body is composed of 60% water. It's no fun passing out in the grandstands.
- Want to meet the stars? Purchase a Pit Pass** and get up close and personal with your favorite drivers, crew, and officials. This is where the action happens.
- Visit the Pit Area as soon as the racing is complete.** It is open to everyone at this time, and you can meet drivers and teams.
- Keep your eyes open and stay alert at all times** — especially in the Pit Area. Your safety is always our priority, but race cars are fast; never forget where you are.
